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Operations Manager

Late Spring-Early Fall

Full-Time

Second Nature Outdoors (SNO) is an outdoor adventure company located in downtown Fredericton, New Brunswick Canada. Second Nature Outdoors season begins in June with small watercraft rentals such as kayaks, SUP and canoes and bike rentals. We also offer guided tours such as 'Gears and Beers', 'Sunrise Paddle' and 'Paddle and Pint' to name a few and a variety of Paddle Canada adult instructional programs which are offered at our two locations on the Saint John River.

From the end of June till the end of August we deliver our Youth Adventure Camps. These outdoor education style programs are geared for youth ages 6 - 15 and are delivered in a day camp format and include outdoor programming such as sailing, rock climbing, kayaking, SUP and much more.

Second Nature Outdoors is currently recruiting an operations manager to take over mid summer. Prior to assuming the role of Operations Manager, this recruit will serve as the Assistant Manager while they are trained to take on the role of Operation Manager. This position begins in June 2020 and is based on a full-time (4) month contract with the possibility of being renewed in May 2021. The Operations Manager is responsible for the day to day operation of all SNO programs and responsible for the supervision and management of all SNO employees.

The Operations Manager is also responsible for ensuring that our Social Media presence is kept up to date, responding to messages, emails and phone calls in a timely manner. This role requires the successful candidate to have a wide range of experience and ability to adapt to a fast paced ever changing environment.

The Operations Manager reports to the Owner of SNO and will be responsible for managing and being a part of a team. The successful candidate requires experience managing people and projects. This includes scheduling, strong conflict resolution and problem solving skills and ability to not only follow direction but also take initiative. This person will be required to work Thursday - Monday from the time the season begins in June until it ends in September. A maximum of one weekend off per month may be approved.

The Assistant Manager is responsible for assisting with the day to day operations of both the Small Craft Aquatic Center and the Hartt Island Resort rental locations. The Camp Director is responsible for managing a team of staff to ensure the highest level of programming for our campers.
